Marquesas

Hiva Oa – There is a haul out and storage yard in Autona. Yard has space for about 50 boats. They have a small store with a small amount of marine items. Supplies are limited and anything needed will have to come from Tahiti on the bi-monthly supply vessels which is easily done.

Nuku Hiva – Kevin from Nuku Hiva Yacht Services has a service to watch your vessel while at anchor. The bay is large and mud bottom with good holding. Beware if you are planning on leaving your vessel for more than a few months would suggest you purchase a section of chain from Tahiti and use that. Many boats(5+ that I know of) have reported their chain being eaten up after leaving boat for 3+ months. Not due to electrolysis but more to corrosive bottom. Rather than have your main 100m length of chain needing to be replaced using a sacrificial piece of chain makes sense.
