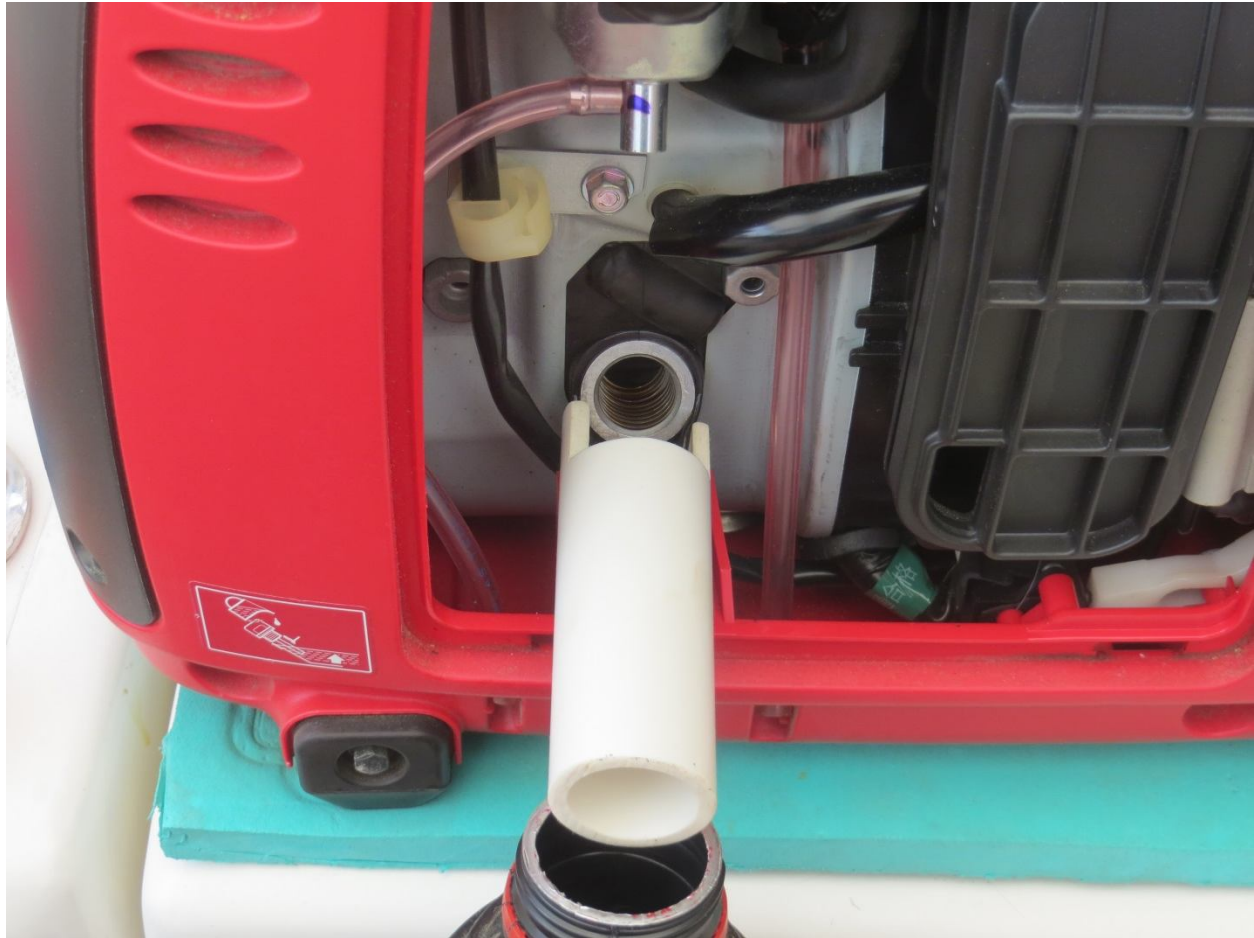


Honda 1000/2000 Oil Change Made Easy

A couple of years ago a great young man named Jack with his folks on the catamaran **Just a Minute** made a few of these oil change devices and gave them out as gifts. It has worked so well that I want to share it with you. I call it changing the Honda oil without spilling a drop.



Obtain a piece of 1" PVC pipe and cut a 4" piece off the length. Then cut a notch out as in the photo above.



Set the Honda on the edge of your cockpit seat.

Remove the cover with a screw driver.

Remove the oil fill plug

Insert the piece of modified 1" PVC pipe between the rubber drain spout and the drain.

Now just tilt the Honda towards you so the preheated hot oil runs down the PVC tube into a junk oil container.



Using the appropriate oil for your Honda use a West System Syringe with the tip cut off slightly to make a larger hole. Using this to refill the Honda (it takes a number of syringes worth to fill up the Honda reservoir).





I also write the date in our work log and also on a small piece of tape and stick it to the inside of the cover.

I hope this makes it slightly less messy to change your Honda generator oil!

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
